The Lifesaving Society's Leadership Recertification Credit System applies to all of the Society's Instructors, Examiners and Trainers. The system is designed to recognize individual needs and interests by encouraging instructors to learn and improve through continuing education and professional development.

The Credit Card has been designed to accommodate the recertification of any or all Lifesaving Society Instructor and their respective Examiner certifications: Swim Instructor, Lifesaving Instructor, Standard First Aid Instructor, National Lifeguard Instructor, and Aquatic Supervisor Instructor.

LIFEGUARDING STATUS

Although it is not required for leadership recertification, the Lifesaving Society recommends that all Instructors hold and maintain current lifeguarding status.

HOW DO I PARTICIPATE?

1 At your convenience, over the two-year recertification period, accumulate three credits by participating in your choice of courses, clinics, and training programs. Credits may be selected either directly from the Credit List, or by having a specific course assigned credit value by the Lifesaving Society.

Lifesaving, Swim Instructors, Officials and Coaches may select their credits from any course contained on the Credit List. Aquatic Supervisor, Standard First Aid, and National Lifeguard Instructors must select their credits from only those courses marked with an asterisk (*). Examiners must select at least one credit from those items marked with a (✓). Instructor Trainers must have a taught an Instructor course.

2 Make sure your credit card is validated (signed and dated) and send it to the Branch office with your recertification fee. If you recertify more than one Instructor, Examiner, or Trainer certification (e.g. Lifesaving Instructor, National Lifeguard Instructor and National Lifeguard Examiner) at the same time, you pay the base fee (\$30.75 in 2022) plus an additional fee (\$9.15 in 2022) for each additional award you wish to recertify to a maximum fee of \$60.00. If you choose to recertify these certifications at various times during the year, you must pay the base fee for each recertification.

3 You will receive your renewed certification card(s), valid for another two years.

CAN I SAVE EXTRA CREDITS FOR NEXT TIME?

No. Credits are valid for a two-year period only. If, for example, you take your National Lifeguard award on January 1, 2020, you must collect your other credits by January 1, 2022. Otherwise, the credit from the National Lifeguard award will have expired and you would be obliged to get another current credit.

The Society has assigned a credit value to the courses below. The credit value and status of these courses may change as modifications are made by the organizations responsible. Because of this, and because new training programs are continually being introduced, the credit list is updated from time to time.

Lifesaving and Swim Instructors, Coach and Lifesaving sport officials may select their three credits from any of the courses listed below. Instructors of all other programs must collect their three credits from only those courses marked with an asterisk *. Examiners must select at least one credit from those items marked with a ✓. Instructor Trainers must have taught an Instructor course. Note: Each item or recertification of each item may be applied only once every two years. Recertification of any item listed below is worth one credit.

- 1. ✓ Teaching one of the following complete courses: Lifesaving Society Swim program, Rookie, Ranger, Star, Basic First Aid, CPR 'A', CPR 'B', CPR 'C', Lifesaving Sport Fundamentals, or coaching Junior Lifeguard Club
2. ✓ Teaching one of the following complete courses: Bronze Star, Emergency First Aid, or Community Official
3. Lifesaving Society Examiner Course
4. Lifesaving Society Trainer Course
5. Lifesaving Society Bronze Medallion certification
6. * Lifesaving Society Bronze Cross certification
7. * Lifesaving Society National Lifeguard Pool, Waterfront, Waterpark and Surf certification (1 credit for each certification)
8. * Lifesaving Society CPR-HCP certification
9. * Lifesaving Society Standard First Aid certification
10. * Lifesaving Society Airway Management certification
11. * Lifesaving Society Aquatic Supervisor certification
12. Lifesaving Society Pool Operator Level 1 or Level 2 certification
13. Lifesaving Society SEE Auditor certification
14. * Lifesaving Society Aquatic Safety Inspector certification
15. * Lifesaving Society Auditor appointment
16. *✓ Conducting three or more examinations as an Examiner (Bronze Medallion or higher)
17. Lifesaving Sport Community Official or higher certification
18. *✓ Judge/Official at Provincial Lifesaving or Lifeguard Championships
19. * Competitor at Provincial Lifesaving or Lifeguard Championships
